**WARNING:** The lynch pin in the handle linkage needs to be removed to operate the lift, but should be installed while the snowmobile is lifted to ensure that someone doesn't lower the snowmobile at the wrong time or by accident.

Be sure to check out the Handle Bar Cup! Attaches to the Power-Lift in seconds.

**STEP 1:** Attach the center post to the base using 2-short bolts and nuts supplied. Tighten them until there is no movement between the base and the center post.



**STEP 2:** Slide the handle assembly into the center post and install the lynch pin through the hole to achieve the desired lift height.
